Panoshe Ranch Information & Rules

Panoshe Ranch is a 10 acre ranch off of Excelsior Road and Calvine Road in Sacramento, just minutes from Highway 50 or Highway 99. We offer several schooling shows throughout the year for you to practice refining your skills and have a little fun in the sun! Horses and riders of all levels are welcome!

Boarding is available. Ask for a tour.

Just a few rules:

- * All show days, classes begin at 8:00 am.
- * We will do our best to run classes in listed order.
- * Formal show attire or casual wear is allowed, however rider boots are required.
- * Helmets are encouraged for everyone, though mandatory for junior riders when mounted on a horse.
- * Horse protective leg wear is allowed on all horses in all classes.
- * USEF and USDF rules will be loosely followed.
- * Registration for Dressage and Western Dressage closes Wednesday prior to the show date.
- * Overnight horse boarding is available by request. Ask about fees.
- * Ribbons placing 1st-6th; First place ribbon winners also earn a prize.
- * The High-Point is awarded based on points accumulated during the season at end of show season. If the Rider wishes to compete in the overall end of the year high point they must pay the high point nomination fee at each show. Scores are given a point value and then will be totaled to determine high point.
- * Refreshments and BBQ lunch are available for purchase.
- * Please leave your dog at home. (We have some very friendly cats).
- * Smoking is allowed INSIDE your own vehicle only. Thank you.
- * The most important rule is to smile and have fun!
